The Spirit of Giving

Guest Speaker: Rev. Tim Costello AO

Tim Costello is recognised as one of Australia's leading voices on social justice issues, having spearheaded public debates on gambling, urban poverty, homelessness, reconciliation and substance abuse.

Since 2004, as Chief Executive of World Vision Australia, Tim has been instrumental in ensuring that global poverty is on the national agenda. His passion for justice and for helping poor communities in the developing world quickly became evident when the devastating Asia tsunami struck on Boxing Day, 2004. The leadership he showed at the time helped to inspire an unprecedented outpouring of generosity from the Australian public, with World Vision Australia raising more than \$100 million for tsunami relief.

Tim has also played a prominent role in the Make Poverty History campaign. He is the current Chairman of the National Australia Bank's community advisory council, a member of the Alcohol Education and Rehabilitation Foundation, and Chairman of the Community Council for Australia, a peak body for the Not For Profit sector.

Prior to joining World Vision Australia, Tim was the Minister of the Collins Street Baptist Church, Melbourne, and Executive Director of Urban Seed, a Christian not-for-profit outreach service for the urban poor. Tim's political "career" extended to successfully running for Mayor of St Kilda in 1993.

Tim studied law and education at Monash University, followed by theology at the International Baptist Seminary in Rueschlikon, Switzerland. He also attained a Masters Degree in Theology from the Melbourne College of Divinity.

Tim's contribution to Australian society has been eminently recognised. He was Victorian of the Year in 2004 and made an Officer of the Order of Australia in 2005.
